Median of market expectations for prices indices declined last week as tracked by Banco Central do Brasil daily survey. For 2000, expectations for IGP-DI decreased to 7.00% from 7.40%; median forecasts for the IGP-M were revised to 7.14% from 7.38%; expectations for the IPC-Fipe moved to 5.40% from 5.82%, forecasts for inflation measured by IPCA declined to 6.10% from 6.13%. GDP growth in 2000 increased to 3.35%, from 3.20% recorded last week. For year 2001, 4% GDP growth is expected. Trade balance surplus is now expected to be at US\$4.9 billion in 2001 from US\$5.11 billion last week. Median of forecasts for the current account deficit increased to US\$23.6 billion from US\$23.4 billion for 2000 and to US\$23.3 billion from US\$ 23.2 billion 2001.


