Inflation expectations continued to fall over the week. Median of market expectations for consumer price inflation - as tracked by the IPCA - hit the target of 6% in 2000 for the first time since October 1999. For 2001, expectations point to inflation of 4.3%. The median for the IPC-Fipe fell to 5.06%, reaching its lowest level since September 1999. The variation of consumer prices in São Paulo is projected to fall to 4.1% in the coming year. Median expectations for other economic indicators are listed below.




