March 24, 2000

Median of market expectations for inflation measured by the IGP-DI for 2000 declined to 7.70% from 7.85% as tracked by Banco Central do Brasil daily survey. Market forecasts for index IGP-M for 2000 moved down to 7.83% from 7.97% last week. Median expectations for the IPCA for 2000 remained at 6.50%. GDP growth expectations remained at 3.00% for 2000 and 4.00% for 2001. Expectations for the trade balance remained unchanged at US\$ 3.72 billion in 2000 increasing to US\$ 5.79 in 2001.


