Median of market expectations for inflation measured by the INPC for 2000 declined to 5.50% from 5.80% as tracked by Banco Central do Brasil daily survey. Inflation expectations for the other indices remained mostly unchanged. Consensus forecast for the IPCA remained at 6.0% for 2000 and at 4.30% for 2001. Median expectations for GDP growth in 2000 was kept at 3.45%, while a growth of 4.0% is expected for 2001. Forecasts for the current account deficit increased last week to US\$ 23.85 billion from U\$ 23.70 billion. Expectations for other economic indicators are quoted in the tables below and in the figures on the next page.


